SAFE ENVIRONMENT

Safety is key for us at the university and faculty. In this leaflet, you will find important information and procedures on how to react in case of a security incident.

- 1. Be aware of your surroundings and let someone know if something seems dangerous to you.
- **a)** It could be a suspicious object or person.
- **b)** Always contact any faculty staff member you trust. You can also contact the LFP security guard or LFP security specialist.
- c) If a physical incident occurs or there is another serious danger, call the police directly at tel. 158.
- 2. Do not bring weapons or other self-defense means into the building.

If you do not feel safe, turn to the LFP security guard or LFP security specialist.

- 3. In the event of a serious physical incident (including shooting):
- a) If you can, RUN!
- **b)** If you cannot run, HIDE!
- c) If you cannot hide, FIGHT!

Once you are safe, call 158.

4. If you find a suspected IED (improvised explosive device):

- **a)** Do not touch the object; don't open it under any circumstances.
- **b)** Move to a safe distance. If you can see the object, you are not in safety.
- c) Inform the LFP security guard, the police at tel. 158.
- **d)** Where possible, strongly caution others around you not to approach the object.

5. If you feel anxious at the faculty,

or need psychological consultation, do not hesitate to contact the faculty ombudsman at tel. 377 593 346, email: ombudsman@lfp.cuni.cz, or any of the crisis and intervention psychological help lines.
