



Student Inquiry? Why Fill It Out?

Because your feedback matters to us!

Here are a few tips on how to express it effectively!

- Be specific and to the point – always support your comments with concrete examples.
- Acknowledge what went well.
- Describe what was beneficial for you and what should be continued.
- Suggest what could be done differently next time – what was missing in the teaching or what didn't help you complete the course.
- Be critical, but don't focus only on the negatives.



Examples of Helpful Comments:

Positive

1. What did I appreciate about the teaching?

"All the teachers were passionate about the subject, explained the material clearly, and often added real-life examples, which helped me understand the context. They were also happy to answer our questions."

2. What helped me complete the course?

"The requirements for passing the credit and exam were clear from the beginning. I knew what I had to do and when, and I didn't have to search for information."

3. What helped me remember and understand the material better?

"The teaching was very visual – we used images, videos, and interactive diagrams. That really helped me retain the information."

Negative

1. What would have helped me understand the material better?

"It would have helped to have more discussions with classmates during class and to do more group work. I was able to learn the theoretical content from the presentations on my own, but I struggled to connect the concepts into a bigger picture."

2. What was the most difficult part of completing the course?

"I didn't know exactly what to study for the exam. The textbooks are too extensive, and it wasn't clear what was essential. A summary of the main topics—like learning outcomes—would have helped."

3. What changes would have helped me manage the course better?

"I would have appreciated more opportunities to check my understanding during the semester—like short quizzes. I only realized I had misunderstood something when I got to the exam."

Examples of Unhelpful Comments:

"Everything was fine."

"Seriously? I didn't like the course at all!"
