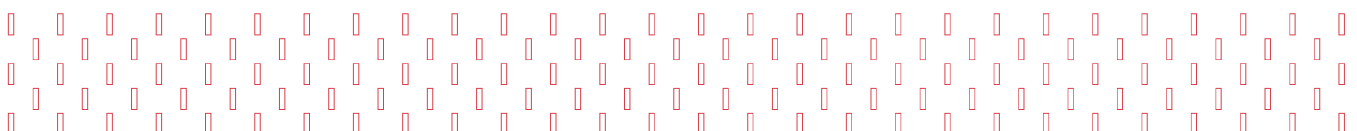
#### Tuition Fees for the academic year 2025/2026

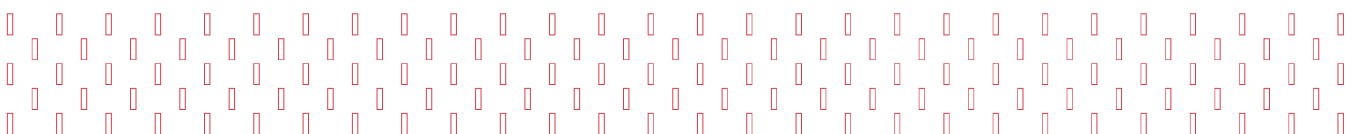
**Fees for the admission procedure for the academic year 2027/2028**

- 2.1 Application to the Master's Degree Programme in both Czech and English . . . . . 1 000 CZK
- 2.2 Application for doctoral studies in Czech and English . . . . . 900 CZK
- 2.3 Fee for acts related to the assessment of admission to study . . . . . 1 050 CZK

**Art. 3**

**Repayment schedule for the extended study fee**

- 3.1 Upon application, the Dean of the Faculty may authorize a payment plan for the fee for a longer course of study.
- 3.2 The student must repay the fee for a longer course of study within two years from the date of the



application for a repayment plan.

- 3.3 In the event that the student fails to fulfil the obligation set out in paragraph 3.2 of this Article, the Dean of the Faculty shall decide on the recovery of the remaining amount due. Collection shall be carried out by the Rector's Office of Charles University.

**Art. 4**  
**Transitional and final provisions**

- 4.1 For students who have applied for a repayment plan before this measure comes into force, the time limits for the repayment plan are governed by the previous measure.
- 4.2 This measure shall come into force and effect on the date of signature by the Dean of the Faculty.<sup>1</sup>
- 4.3 This measure cancels Dean's Measure No. 8/2024 - Fees associated with studies for the academic year 2024/2025 and fees associated with the admission procedure for the academic year 2025/2026.
