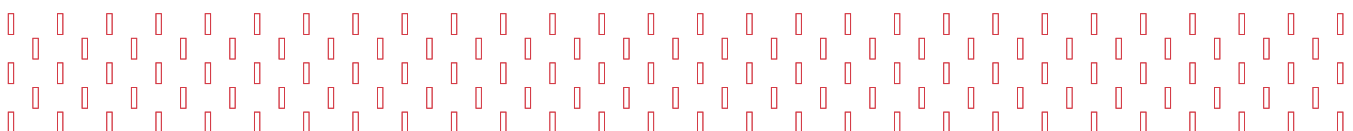
## DEAN'S MEASURE NO. 5/2026 ON HEALTH SERVICES FOR STUDENTS

### Article 1 Subject of modification

- 1.1 The health care of students who have enrolled to study at the Faculty of Medicine in Pilsen of Charles University (hereinafter referred to as the “faculty”) is ensured by a provider of health services chosen by students themselves according to Act No. 372/2011 Coll., on health services and conditions of their provision. The choice of the provider is not limited by the faculty.
- 1.2 Before enrolling in the study, the candidate for the study shall provide evidence of:
  - a) a certificate of medical fitness to study,
  - b) a certificate of vaccination against viral hepatitis B and measles.
- 1.3 During the last year of study at the faculty, students undergo an exit preventive examination.

### Article 2 Certificate of medical fitness to study

- 2.1 All admitted applicants for study shall undergo a medical examination confirming their medical fitness to study before enrolling in studies with a healthcare service provider, to the extent specified in the implementing regulations.
- 2.2 The original Certificate of Medical Fitness for Study for Applicant to the Faculty of Medicine in Pilsen of Charles University (hereinafter referred to as the “Certificate of Fitness”), stamped and signed by a general practitioner, shall be submitted by the applicant upon enrollment in the study; the date of issue of the Certificate of Fitness may not be older than 6 months on the date of enrollment in the study. The employee of the study department shall store the Certificate of Fitness in the student’s personal file.
- 2.3 If an applicant for study does not submit a Certificate of Fitness when enrolling in the 1<sup>st</sup> year, he/she will not be enrolled in the study.
- 2.4 The Certificate of Fitness form is Annex No. 1 to this measure.



### **Article 3**

#### **Vaccination against viral hepatitis B**

- 3.1 Based on the Decree of the Ministry of Health of the Czech Republic No. 537/2006 Coll., on vaccination against infectious diseases, as amended, admitted applicants for study are obliged to undergo a special vaccination against viral hepatitis B.
- 3.2 The healthcare provider will confirm to the applicant for study the certificate of vaccination against viral hepatitis B, which is Annex No. 2 to this measure.
- 3.3 The vaccination certificate referred to in the previous paragraph, stamped and signed by the relevant healthcare provider, shall be submitted by the applicant upon enrolment. The student affairs officer shall store the certificate in the student's personal file and confirm the submission of the certificate in the student's study report.
- 3.4 If an applicant for study does not provide a certificate of vaccination against viral hepatitis B when enrolling in the 1st year, he/she will not be enrolled in the study.

### **Article 4**

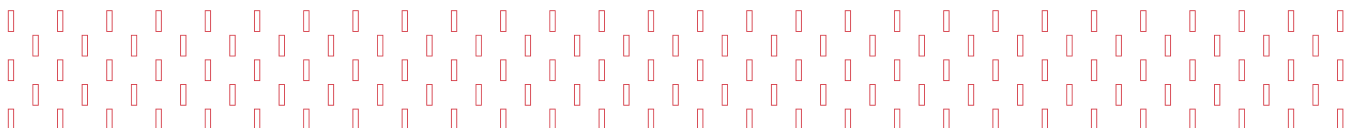
#### **Vaccination against measles**

- 4.1 Applicants are required to undergo measles vaccination.
- 4.2 The healthcare provider will confirm to the applicant for study the measles vaccination certificate, which is Annex No. 2 to this measure.
- 4.3 The vaccination certificate referred to in the previous paragraph, stamped and signed by the relevant healthcare provider, shall be submitted by the applicant upon enrolment. The student affairs officer shall store the certificate in the student's personal file and confirm the submission of the certificate in the student's study report.
- 4.4 If an applicant for study does not provide a certificate of vaccination against measles when enrolling in the 1<sup>st</sup> year, he/she will not be enrolled in the study.

### **Article 5**

#### **Exit Preventive Medical Examination**

- 5.1 During the last year of study all student shall undergo the exit preventive medical examination at the health service provider. The confirmation of the completion of the examination shall be submitted by the students to the study department by the end of the study, but no later than the date of the fulfillment of all study obligations given by the relevant study plan.
- 5.2 The study department officer files the confirmation in the student's personal file.
- 5.3 In the event that the student refuses to undergo this examination, the study department officer will record the refusal of the examination signed by the student and the study department officer. If the student refuses to sign this declaration, then the employee of the study department officer is obliged to make an accurate written record of this fact, which will be confirmed by the study department officer and the head of the study department. The same procedure applies to cases where a student has undergone an exit preventive medical examination but has not documented this fact for any reason. These documents are always filed in the student's personal file.
- 5.4 The form with the confirmation of the exit preventive medical examination is Annex No. 3 to this measure.



**Article 6**  
**Final Provision**

- 6.1 This measure comes into force on the date of signature by the Dean and comes into effect on 1 April 2026.<sup>1</sup>
- 6.2 This measure cancels Dean's Measure No. 6/2025 - On Health Care for Students.
